We are looking for an ambitious and target driven expert to join our External Relations team as a Senior Manager Partnerships Development as we expand our capacity in the area of building partnership and leveraging resources to complement a new strategic growth plan.

The job incumbent will be mainly responsible for developing, managing, and optimizing EAA's relationships with bilateral and multilateral organizations who are part of the ODA system. Additionally, is responsible for the process of identifying, researching, assessing, negotiating, and managing these categories of organizations in conformity with EAA strategic goals and in consultation with the Executive Management.

The Senior Manager for Partnerships Development will assist to lead and set strategic directions to improve and expand EAA's partnerships as well as structure appropriate solicitation strategies that ensure critical resources for advancing the Foundation's work.

The Senior Manager for Partnerships Development will help to drive the foundation's strategic engagement and partnerships through the mobilization and leveraging of resources in order to maximize flexible, longer-term revenue in support of EAA's programmes, in line with the 2030 Global Agenda for Sustainable Development. Under the direction of the director, the incumbent will collaborate closely with EAA programmes and other outreach functions to strengthen their relations with key partners and expand their engagement.



Key Duties and Activities include but are not limited to;

- Manage the implementation of specialized, comprehensive, and analytical research on potential
 partnerships for EAA (i.e. partnerships under the Official Development Assistance (ODA) categories,
 philanthropic foundations, and universities) as well as any relevant categories in line with higher
 management instructions.
- Undertake adequate due diligence and screening process for potential EAA partners based on the identified guidelines.
- Formulate, manage and monitor the ODA and Partnerships sub department strategies and business
 plans to strengthen existing partnerships and form new partnerships under his/her responsibility
- Draft, develop and review partnership proposals and analysis as required in coordination with other relevant program and departments
- Manage the development of presentation tools and documents for potential partners.
- Manage the communications and negotiations with the potential partners and record correspondences as required.
- Design and implement the Partnership Framework and Procedures, ensuring partnership processes are followed, risk mitigated and relationships managed with quality and equality
- Conceptualize innovative ways for cooperation with potential partners to support achieving EAA's strategic objectives.
- Assist to ensure mechanisms are in place to regularly review and monitor the performance of the ODA & Partnerships sub-department and take appropriate corrective actions to achieve goals and targets.
- Operate and monitor existing partnerships to ensure smooth implementation of relevant projects and partnership outcomes.
- Review relevant strategies of ODAs and MDBs partners and identify common areas of development
- opportunities for the EAA. Troubleshoot any issues encountered and take the needed actions for improvements and optimization.
- Work as a part of one team to ensure achieving department's KPIs and objectives. Brainstorm and collaborate with other colleagues/teams for new ideas and initiates.
- Support the External Relations Department and other EAA programs and departments by developing and implementing the EAA ODA Dashboard mapping of non-EAA ODA Projects implemented worldwide.

 Master's degree in International Development, International Relations, Public Policy; or other related area. Equivalent professional work experience in the Strategic Partnerships area, combined with a university degree in a related field is acceptable.

Work Experience;

 Minimum of 12 years' of progressively relevant professional experience notably in the field of resource mobilization, including within the corporate sector, of which preferably 5 years of experience at the management level.
